City Council Update

The City Council opened their April City Council meeting with the second public hearing to hear citizens' comments on amending variance requirements in the City's Zoning Ordinance after which they adopted an Ordinance finalizing the amendments. They also held a public hearing to hear comments for submission of an application for a loan with Oregon Transportation Infrastructure Bank for improvements to City Streets and infrastructure.

Other agenda items consisted of:

- Authorized the Mayor to sign a Maintenance Assistance Program (MAP) A location Certificate Agreement with the State of Oregon to receive \$3,600 to maintain the facilities at Coyote Evans Park.
- Authorized the Mayor to sign an engagement letter with Michael L. Piels Certified Public Accountants, to perform audit services for the year ending June 20, 2013.
- Accepted a resignation from Tree City Committee member Mary Ritch and the Mayor presented her with a Certificate of Appreciation for 20 years of service and her Outstanding Dedication and Community Commitment
- The Mayor read Proclamations setting the following observation dates for celebration in Rogue River:

National Day of Prayer - May 2, 2013 Honor the Dead by Helping the Living - May 3, 2013 Municipal Clerks Week - May 5 to May 11, 2013 National Police Week - May 13 to May 18, 2013 Peace Officer's Memorial Day - May 13, 2013

The City Council recognized earning the designation of "Tree City, USA" for the 30th year. Rogue River was first certified as a "Tree City, USA" in 1983 due to the focused effort of Anna Classick, nicknamed by the City as "First Lady of Trees." In 1990 she was awarded the Enerson award from the National Arbor Day Foundation for her efforts in planting trees throughout the City.

City Administrator Mark Reagles announced that Oregon Urban and Community Forestry had awarded the City "Tree City of the Year." They will make a presentation to the City Council sometime in May.

Both accomplishments come from the time and dedication of volunteers such as Anna Classick, Sue Bloomfield, Jim Smith, Evelyn Marsh, Mary Ritch, Don Moody, JoAnn Dixon, Karen Thornton, and others that gave of themselves for the promotion and protection of community trees and improving the quality of life for our citizens.
