# City Council Update

During the month of July the Mayor and City Council worked with the City Administrator developing an Entry Level 1 Planner/Public Works Assistant job description and salary range. The City had been notified by Building Department Services (BDS) that they would no longer be providing the City with a contract Planner so the City has decided to once again employ a full time City Planner who will work closely with the Public Works Department with building plans, the TMDL requirements, storm water management and grant projects.

The only other item on the agenda was authorizing the Mayor to sign an agreement with the State of Oregon Department of Transportation providing if the City were confronted with an emergency situation requiring the personnel, equipment or material not available to it, the City may request assistance from any of the other parties who had executed the same agreement.

REMEMBER: All City meetings are open to the public except for Executive Sessions. Meeting dates and times can be found

on the City's website or at City Hall.

# **Firefighters Installing and Testing Smoke Alarms**



The Rogue River Fire District has received 50 smoke 3:00a.m.alarms by the Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal and will be offering free smoke alarms and installation service for residents

of the Rogue River Fire District. The purpose of this program is to provide smoke alarms to residences that are otherwise unprotected in the event of a fire. The National Fire Protection Association research shows that working smoke alarms cut the chance of dying in a fire by half and that three out of five deaths result from fires in homes that have no smoke alarms or non-working smoke alarms.
