City Council



Mayor Pam VanArsdale called the City Council meeting to Order followed with an Inspirational Invocation from Pastor Bob McKenzie with Foots Creek Chapel.

To accommodate the holidays the November meeting was held one week early. The business portion of the meeting consisted of the following items:

- > Authorizing the Mayor to sign a State of Oregon, Land Conversation & Development 2015-2017 Planning Assistance Grant Agreement
- > Authorizing the Mayor to sign a Retainer Agreement for Legal Counsel and Advisor to the City and its officials with Steve Rich, Attorney at Law
- ➤ Adopted the 2016-2017 Budget Calendar
- > Appointed City Administrator Mark Reagles as the Budget Officer
- ➤ Reappointed Budget Committee members Jo Anne Mead, Don Collins and Keith Willard
- > Approved to be a Platinum Level Sponsor donation of \$220 to help furnish 20-meals at the Free Traditional Turkey Dinner
- > Granted a six-month extension to Foothill Estates for the landscaping of the Common Areas in Phase I & II
- ➤ Approved to donate \$220 to help with the "4th Annual Christmas Project" to help families in Rogue River

City Administrator Mark Reagles announced that the City had been mentioned in a recent issue of Pipeline who noticed that the City was an "Outstanding Performer" for the water system. The City was listed in an elite group of 30-water systems in Oregon. This will also allow the City an extension of reporting dates.

REMEMBER: With the exception of Executive Sessions, all meetings are open the public. The City Council and Planning Commission welcome your attendance and comments during these meetings.
