# City Council Update

The May City Council meeting opened with a heartfelt and encouraging Invocation from the new Foots Creek Chapel Pastor, Richard Wheeler.

After Committee reports were heard the City Council made decisions on the following items, some of them controversial, some mandated, others pleasurable:

- A Resolution establishing a marijuana and marijuana infused product tax fee
- A Resolution allowing business license issuance for the purpose of operating medical marijuana facilities
- A Resolution certifying the municipal services for the City held a public hearing to hear comments from the citizens on the use of State Revenue Sharing funds
- A Resolution declaring the City's election to receive State Revenue Sharing funds
- Held a Budget Hearing to hear comments from the citizens about the 2015-2016 budget as approved by the Budget Committee
- A Resolution authorizing application for the 2016 Special City Allotment Grant for street improvements on portions of Oak and First Streets
- An amendment to an Intergovernmental Agreement for additional cost for legal services on the proposed cable franchise with Charter Communications
- Notice of Intent to Award for the Anna Classick Bicentennial Park Tennis Court Rehabilitation
- Regretfully accepted a resignation from Planning Commissioner Shirley O'Gara
- Swore in recently appointed Planning Commissioner Dean Stirm
- Authorized a donation to the educational fund of League of Oregon Cities
- Authorized the Mayor to sign liquor license applications and waive the fees for upcoming fund raiser's on June 6, 2015 and June 26 and 27, 2015 being conducted by the Cattlemen's Saloon
- Authorized a closure of Gilmore Street for a car show on July 12, 2015 being conducted by the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4116
- Authorized a donation to the Miss Rogue River Scholarship Pageant fund

The Mayor, City Council and staff are working with the Chamber of Commerce and the Rogue River Kiwanis for the "62<sup>nd</sup> Annual National Rooster Crowing Contest" weekend being held on the last Saturday in June to be the best ever. #### **MAYOR'S CORNER**

Your Council and I are considering adding a fee to the water/sewer bills to generate enough revenue to hire a fifth officer for our Police Department. We're looking at \$5 per month. Keeping Rogue River safe is a top priority for us and it's been a struggle for our Police Department to keep up with the increasing needs of our community. Scheduling around days off and vacation time is challenging but illness and injuries can't be planned for and when two of our guys are sick at the same time, it really puts a burden on the other two. That fifth officer will make a big difference for them as well as increase the time they can be out on patrol.

I'm excited to be able to announce that the World Changers are coming to Rogue River in June of 2016! This is a faith-based group of approximately 200+ young people that will be spending the week before Rooster Crow next year doing a variety of fix-it projects throughout the community. They'll be looking for projects so please help these kids by letting them help you. We'll have much more info as the time gets nearer, but for now, if you have any questions, contact Jill Stickler at Grace Baptist Church.

And lastly, my disaster preparedness tip for this month is a simple thing that many of us overlook (though required by building code now) – attaching earthquake straps to your water heater. They make a kit that you can buy here in town at Main Building.
