City Council Update

The Mayor opened the May City Council meeting with an invocation from City Administrator Mark Reagles. During the meeting the City Council took action on the following agenda items.

- > Amended an Ordinance restricting the business of yard sales and garage sales raising the cost to \$2 per sale
- > Adopted a Resolution amending a job description for City Recorder
- > Adopted a Resolution establishing a salary range for the position of City Recorder
- > Adopted a Resolution consenting to a redisignation of Jackson County's Enterprise Zone
- > Ratified a phone poll conducted on April 4, 2017, for the purpose of appointing Carole Poling and John Bond to the Budget Committee
- > Adopted the 2017-2018 5-Year Capital Improvement Program
- > Authorized the Mayor to sign an agreement between the City and Civil West Engineering Services for basic engineering services necessary to properly plan, design, bid, manage and inspect construction projects
- > Authorized the Mayor to sign an agreement between the City and KDP Certified Public Accountants to perform auditing services for the 2016-2017 budget year

- > Approved a request from Faith Lutheran Church to waive the reservation fee to use Palmerton Park for a church picnic
- > Authorized the Mayor to sign an Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for a new outlet business for off premises sales at 8981 Rogue River Highway, applicant ASHOC BALA LLC, Rakesh Sharma
- > Approved a request from the Rogue River Kiwanis to purchase a full page colored ad for the "64th Annual National Rooster Crowing Event" pamphlet
- > Mayor Pam VanArsdale read Proclamations declaring May 7-13, 2017 as "Municipal Clerks Week" and May 14-20 as "Police Week and Police Memorial Day" in the City of Rogue River and asked that the citizens join her honoring these individuals

Memorial Day was originally called Decoration Day and was initiated to honor the soldiers for the Union and Confederate armies who died during the American Civil War.

Celebrations honoring Civil War heroes started the year after the war ended. The establishment of a public holiday was meant to unify the celebration as a national day of remembrance instead of a holiday celebrated separately by the Union and



Confederate states. By the late 19th century. the holiday became known as Memorial Day and was expanded to include the deceased veterans of all the wars fought by American ln forces. 1971. Memorial Day became federal holiday.
