### City Council Update

Mayor Pam called the meeting to Order and Welcomed Pastor Lucas Bradburn from the Rogue Valley Community Church who delivered the Invocation followed with the Mayor directing everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance. After the Committee Reports were delivered the following items were taken action on:

- → A presentation by Nick Haile, ODF Stewardship Forester - Southern Oregon District presented to members of the Tree City Committee and the Mayor and City Council with the 35-Year Tree City, USA flag and sticker for Arbor Day Celebrations.
- City Councilors  $\rightarrow$  Two new appointed Wayne Stuart and Ryan Hess were sworn-in then took their seats at the podium.
- → City Councilor Wayne Stuart was the appointed to Emergency Communications of Southern Oregon, also known as ECSO, the Finance Committee and the City's Liaison to the Rogue River Community Center.
- → A Resolution was adopted authorizing the signatures for banking services on behalf of the City
- → A Resolution was adopted authorizing the City to apply for a Large Development Grant from the Oregon Parks Recreation Department for development of Rooster Park and delegating authority.
- → The 5-Year Capital Improvement Plan was approved for the 2018-2019 budget year.
- → Approved a request from Chelsea Booth for the Mayor to sign a new Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Bee Gee's Diner at 500 East Main Street.
- → Approved a request from Jaquinder Heer and Parminder Kaur for the Mayor to sign a new Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for A-1 Market at

8981 Rogue River Highway.

- → Denied a request from Bill and Jinny Neiswanger for the Mayor to sign an Control Oregon Liquor Commission Temporary Use of an Annual License at 108 Depot Street.
- → Denied a request from Bill and Jinny Neiswanger to close down Depot Street to accommodate vendors and live music on April 21, 2018.
- → Approved a request from Ryan Allard Board President of the Evans Valley Community Association to hang a banner across Depot Street for the Elk Mountain Highland Games being held on April 28-29, 2018.
- $\rightarrow$  The Mayor read a Proclamation declaring Thursday, April 12, 2018 as the day to celebrate "Arbor Day" in Rogue River.

You may have already noticed a change at Rooster Park. The City Council directed staff to post "NO DOGS ALLOWED IN PARK" signs in preparation for Rooster Crow and the development of Rooster Park. Violators will be cited into the Rogue River Municipal Court under RRMC 8.05.

The next meeting that the City Council will be convening is the Budget Committee at 3:00 pm on Thursday, April 12. The Budget Committee consists of the Mayor, six City Councilors and seven individuals from the community. Then at 6:00 p.m. Thursday, April 26, 2018 is the City Council meeting. These meetings are open to the public and a great opportunity to witness your City Government at work.

promotional items.


#### **MAYOR'S CORNER**
