Your "City Council's Update"

Mayor Pam VanArsdale opened the meeting Welcoming County Commissioner Colleen Roberts and her Mom Jessie and Pastor Dale Schaffner with New Beginnings Church who delivered the Invocation.

The City Council dealt with the following agenda items just in time before losing power from the storm that blew through:

- Accepted a withdrawal of an appeal that had been continued from April 26, 2018 filed by Richard Porta with Gold River Botanical's regarding a sign permit.
- Adopted a Resolution certifying the municipal services provided by the City for the 2018-2019 budget vear.
- Adopted a Resolution extending Workers' Compensation coverage to volunteers of the City for the 2018-2019 budget year.
- Adopted a Resolution declaring the City's election to receive State Revenue Sharing for the 2018-2019 budget year.
- ► Adopted a Resolution authorizing funds to be used in the financial management of the City for the 2018-2019 budget year.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting the budget, making appropriations, and levying taxes for the City for the 2018-2019 budget year.
- Adopted a Resolution adopting the City of Rogue River's representation in the updates to the Jackson County Multi-jurisdictional Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan.
- Authorized the Mayor to sign a Restated Intergovernmental Agreement of Emergency Communications of Southern Oregon between the City and Emergency Communications of Southern Oregon.
- Authorized the Mayor to sign an Agreement for 9-1-1 Answering and Dispatch Services between the City and Emergency Communications Agency of Southern Oregon.
- ► Authorized the Mayor to sign an Engagement Letter between the City and KDP, Certified

Public Accounts, LLP, to conduct audits services for the year ending June 30, 2018.

- ► Ratified a consensus taken for a request from the Cal-Ore River Racers to authorize the Mayor to sign an application for a Permit to Hold a Marine Event, Regatta or Parade for the Rooster Crow Hydroplane Race on June 30, 2018 and July 1, 2018.
- ► Approved a request from Julia Hendricks, Director of the Rogue River Greenway, Ride the Rogue, to serve beer and wine during their 2018 event.
- ► Authorized the Mayor to sign an Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Temporary Use of an Annual License for ID's Sports Pub, LLC, to serve during the 2018 Ridethe-Rogue event being held in Palmerton Park on Saturday, September 22, 2018. Applicant: Jack DiMatteo.
- ► Authorized the Mayor to sign an Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Temporary Use of an Annual License for Cattlemen's Saloon, to serve alcohol in an outdoor area being held at 108 Depot Street during Rooster Crow on June 29-30, 2018. Applicant: Bill Neiswanger, Owner.
- ► Authorized the Mayor to sign an Oregon Liquor Control Commission application for Temporary Use of an Annual License for Rogue River Veterans of Foreign Wars & Auxiliary Post 4116, to serve alcohol in an outdoor area for the High School Scholarship Fundraiser being held on September 8, 2018. Applicant: Sherry Prudhon.
- ► Approved a request from the Rogue River Professional Firefighters Association Local 3513 to conduct their annual "Fill the Boot" drive for Muscular Dystrophy on Saturday, June 9, 2018. Applicant: Mike Hammond.
- ► The Mayor read a Proclamation declaring Friday, May 25, 2018 as the official day of distributing Buddy Poppies in the City of Rogue River by the Veterans of Foreign Wars & Auxiliary Post 4116.

The "MAYOR'S CORNER"

I was given the honor of saying a few words at the Memorial Day Observance at Woodville Cemetery again this year. For those of you who weren't able to attend, I thought I'd share my short speech here:

"Someone once said "Courage is the willingness to be afraid but to act anyway". This is true of every soldier, in every war and conflict our Nation has seen."

Those of us who have not served will never fully understand the sacrifices our soldiers make. Since the birth of these United States, there have always been courageous men and women standing in the gap to protect our nation and ensure our freedoms.

As we set today aside to honor those that gave their lives doing so, let us be mindful that we should do this every day of the year and not just this one. And let us also remember that the preservation of our freedom and our way of life is not just the duty of our soldiers but must be undertaken by all citizens.

City Councilor Don Dougherty recited a poem at the end of our council meeting the other night called "Freedom is not Free", written by a young man named Kelly Strong. Its poignant message is clear and though the fallen have paid the ultimate price, it is up to each and every one of us to contribute to the cost of freedom by ensuring our democracy does not fail. To make democracy work, we must be a nation of participants, not simply observers. As former Justice Marshall Thurgood said, "Where you see wrong or inequality or injustice, speak out, because this is your country. This is your democracy. Make it. Protect it. Pass it on."

After you leave here today, whether you're planning to BBQ with family and friends, go shopping or do yardwork. I ask that you take a few moments to say a prayer of thanks to all of those that gave up their tomorrows that you might have the freedoms of today."
