City Council Update

The August City Council meeting was opened by Mayor Pam who welcomed Pastor Jim McKinney with Grace Baptist Church who delivered the Invocation. Following the Pledge of Allegiance she also welcomed County Commissioner Colleen Roberts.

After the committee reports were completed a gentlemen from the audience addressed the Mayor and City Council with his concerns of lighting being projected from a new commercial building recently built in downtown.

The City Council dealt with the following agenda items:

- The City Recorder Administer the Oath of Service to our new Patrol Officer Brent Miller.
- The Mayor presented her "Mayor's Award of Property Beautification" to the Rogue River Shopping Center for their work they've done on the corner of East Main and Gilmore Streets.
- An agreement was approved authorizing the Mayor to sign a Master Participating Agreement between the City and Jackson County Community Justice for work crew services.
- An agreement was approved authorizing the Mayor to sign an Oregon Cooperative Procurement Program Agreement between the City and the State of Oregon for purchasing

goods, services, or both from any Designated Price Agreement (DAS) Procurement Services.

- A request was granted from Reverend Evan Goeglein with Faith Lutheran Church to wave the Palmerton Park Reservation fee for an event being held on August 25, 2018.
- Regretfully accepted a resignation from Planning Commissioner Cindy England.
- Approved annual Liquor License Renewals for businesses in Rogue River.

The next Council meeting will be held on Thursday, September 27, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. and is always open to the public.

ELECTION UPDATE: The time has come and gone for collecting signatures to be on the November ballot. Although you still have the option of being a Write-In Candidate. Stop in or call City Hall and the City Recorder/Elections Official can help you with the process. The deadline to register to vote is October 16, 2018. Registration cards must be postmarked by this date or submittal online not later than 11:59 p.m.





Fall is approaching and the City has already started thinking about this year's leaf pick-up program. No start date has been set. However, that doesn't mean you can't start raking your leaves and covering them with a tarp or plastic. If your leaves are located in the back yard you can rake them onto a tarp and when the time comes you'll just pull the tarp out to the front of your property.
