City Council Update

Mayor Pro tem Mark Poling opened the meeting Welcoming Pastor Sharon Boland with Hope Alive Church who delivered the evenings Invocation. Mr. Poling then led the City Council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance. After the approval of the August 22, 2019 City Council meeting minutes they heard reports from the Committee Chairs and then the following items were dealt with during the meeting:

- 1 <u>Appointment of Mayor</u>: The City Council voted unanimously to appoint City Councilor Wayne Stuart to fill the position of Mayor for the remaining term of 2019-2020.
- 2 <u>Declare a Vacancy</u>: The City Council voted to declare the vacancy of City Council Position No. 3 and directed staff to advertise for the vacancy.
- 3 <u>Council Bill No. 19-2389; Resolu-</u> <u>tion No. 19-1356-R</u>: They adopted a Resolution for transferring appropriation authority within the General Fund and Street Fund for Budget year beginning July 1,

REMEMBER, sidewalk's are your responsibility!

As a citizen it's your responsibility to keep the sidewalks clear for pedestrian traffic. This is a good time to trim back your bushes, hedges, and trees over the sidewalks and rake any fallen leaves making it easier for people to walk without having to walk out into the street.



AND, IT'S THAT TIME AGAIN!!!

Fall is here and with that leaves have begun to drop. We will start picking up leaves in the City on October 21st. This service will continue through December 31st. Please call 541-582-4401 to schedule a pickup. *This is*



for **LEAVES ONLY**, no grass, animal droppings, tree limbs, rocks or household garbage. The City has a new leaf vacuum, and would like to utilize that as much as possible. All piles of leaves should be in an area accessible within the reach of the 6-foot vacuum hose, but not behind fences, on the sidewalk or in the gutter.

Please do not rake the leaves into open ditches.



The City will also pick up leaves in bags, and if you need bags, stop by City Hall and pick up some. Remember, if you cannot pick up the bag after you have filled it, it is most likely too heavy for our employees to pick them up. Please make sure the bags are 30-pounds or less!
